Step 3: Create a Send Connector Exchange 2010

- 1. Open the Send Connector tab under Server Management > Hub Transport option
- 2. Right-click in the empty space and select **New Send Connector**
- 3. Ensure intended use field is set to **custom**.
- 4. Enter Vautastic in Name field, then click Next
- 5. Click **Add** in the **address space** window
- 6. In the address field, enter {domainprefix}.vaultastic.com
- 7. Select Route mail through the following smart hosts. Click Add..
- 8. Select FQDN. Enter o365-v4.vaultastic.com. Click OK, then Next.
- 9. Leave smart host authentication settings as None. Click Next.
- 0. Choose the Hub Transport Server's that apply. Click Next.
- 1. Preview **Configuration Summary**. On the **New Connector** page, review the configuration summary for the connector.

If you want to modify the settings, click **Back**.

To create the Send connector by using the settings in the configuration summary, click New.

- 2. On the **Completion** page, review the following, and then click **Finish** to close the wizard:
 - A status Completed indicates that the wizard completed the task successfully.
 - A status Failed indicates that the task wasn't completed successfully. If the task fails, review the summary for an explanation, and then click Back to make any configuration changes.
